How do I get a Weehawken Library card?

All you need is proof you live or work in Weehawken.

- Driver's license, lease or bill with Weehawken address
- * Mail with your name and Weehawken address
- * Letter or ID verifying Weehawken employment

Residents can apply in person or at http://www.bccls.org and click on Apply for a Card.

Children ages 6 months –14 may get their own card with a parent /guardian signature.

Patrons under age 14 can check out all materials except DVDs.

There is a \$3 fee to replace a lost library card.

There is no fee to reactivate an expired card, or to transfer your card from another BCCLS library when you move to Weehawken.

How long can I borrow materials?

How many items can I borrow?



Each library user can checkout up to 4 DVDs and CDs at a time and up to a total of 50 items.

How do I renew library items?

- * Renew online at http://catalog.bccls.org with your card number and 4 digit password. Contact us if you need to reset your password.
- * Renew on your mobile device at http://catalog.bccls.org/Mobile/
- * Call 201-863-7823 to renew with your library card number.
- * All items may be renewed 4 times with the exception of DVDs which can be renewed once and Museum Passes which can not be renewed.
- * Items are not renewable if they are "on hold" for another patron.
- * Non Weehawken items are renewed as per the polices of the owning library.

Where can I return items?

All items can be returned to the circulation desks. If the Library is closed please use the outside materials dropbox to return items. Weehawken books and media can also be returned at any BCCLS libraries.

What if I return items late?

Museum Passes \$5.00 a day
DVDs (per item) \$1.00 a day
All other materials (per item) \$0.10 a day

Library cards with more than \$10 in fines are blocked: you cannot use the computers or checkout materials until fines are paid below \$10.

How do I request items?

- * If an item you want is not available here, you may request it from another BCCLS library by placing a hold online at http://www.bccls.org or by calling us with your library card number.
- * We will either call or email you when items arrive.
 Items will held for 4 days.
- * Contact 2nd Floor Reference Desk to request items from other NJ libraries beyond the BCCLS system.

How do I borrow from the Library's Digital Collections?

- Please visit our web site at http://www.bccls.org and click on Digital Collections. You must have your library card number to access these collections.
- * Holds can be place on the e-books and e-audios and yow will receive an e-mail notice when the item is available. Items are held for 72 hours.
- * Items cannot be renewed.

How do I use the computers & internet?

- * We offer free Wi-Fi password-protected access.
- You must bring a valid BCCLS Library card to use the public computers for up to 2 hours. 30 minutes extensions can be requested at the desk and is up to the discretion of the Library staff after 3:00 PM.
- * Computers have MS Office and Internet access.
- * Once you logoff all computer files are erased. Therefore if you need to email or save your documents bring a flash drive or you can purchase one at the Library for \$5.00.
- * The ability to download files/software is limited.
